This convention is an excellent opportunity to reach out to our colleagues in the Cyber Security field and build partnerships and awareness of what ASIS has to offer.

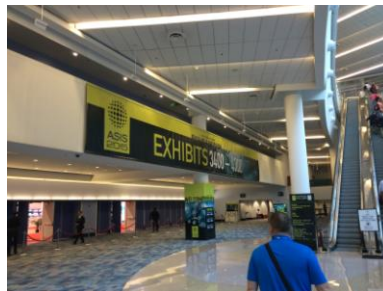
